North Entrance: Remove all mulch, put in new fabric and edging, replace with new mulch Estimate: \$4450

Center Island: Remove mulch and dead plants, put in new fabric, replace mulch with river rock. Estimate: \$4794

Red Bridge Sign Area: Remove all overgrowth, mulch, and general clean up. Replace with rock. Estimate: \$3646

Motion made to hire Midwest Landscapes to do improvements. Motion passed.

- 3. PayHOA update: Many members have already signed up and paid dues online. There are several homeowners that need email addresses to be entered in the system. Heather will send a list out to the board so we may contact neighbors around us.
- 4. Some mailboxes need to be stained and repaired. Tom Gleason is the contact to repair them. Staining should be done after the repairs are done.
